BEACH PER NIGHT



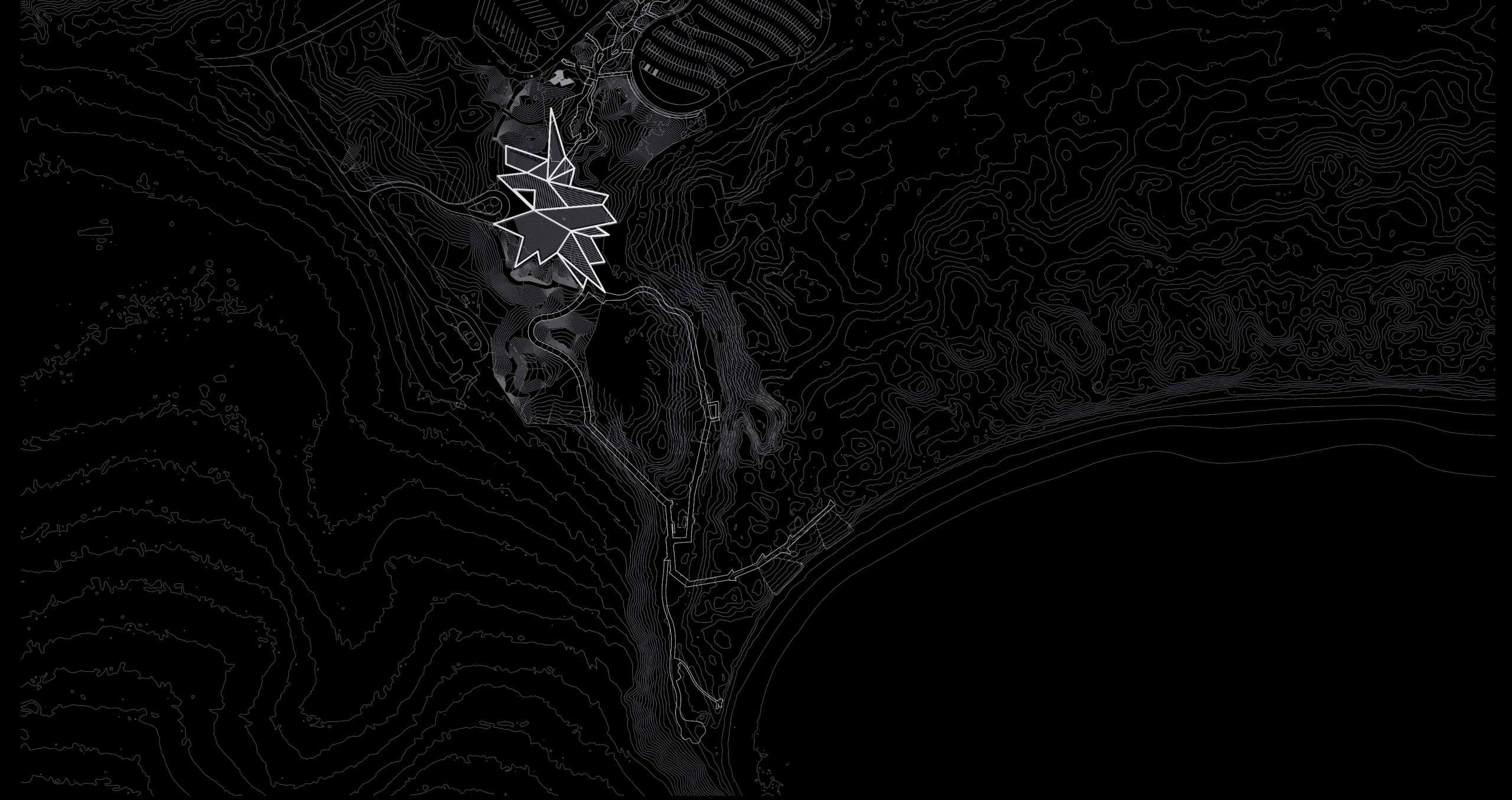
