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ALL STUDENTS COMPLETE OPELA

THE ONLINE POST-ENROLMENT LANGUAGE ASSESSMENT

Supported by the Academic Language and Learning (ALL) team, Subject Coordinators in every faculty instruct **commencing undergraduate and postgraduate coursework students** to complete OPELA in identified core subjects in Week 1. Feedback and results are provided immediately.

STUDENTS PARTICIPATE IN LDO

Students who are unable to attend the

(OPELA) is an online 30-min language
screening task to determine students'
language proficiencies. Students receive a

TARGETED STUDENTS ATTEND LDTs

Students who receive a **Basic** level in OPELA are directed to enrol in a **Language Development Tutorial (LDT).** Designed and taught by the ALL team to **develop students' discipline-specific language and literacy skills,** the 90-min LDTs typically run from Week 3 to Week 12, alongside the subject activities.

LDTs are offered an alternative – the **Language Development Online** program (LDO), which takes a blended approach. In addition, students who receive an 'Unsatisfactory' level in a milestone task are recommended to participate in LDO.

ALL STUDENTS GRADED IN MILESTONE TASKS

A milestone task is an existing individual assignment in a core subject requiring students to display their discipline-specific language and literacy skills. All students are assessed against the assessment criteria in addition to a language framework developed by the ALL team. The language framework has three levels: Unsatisfactory, Needs Development, Satisfactory. **Training is provided to subject markers.**

STUDENTS WHO DON'T COMPLY

Students receive a **W/Fail (X) grade** if they fail to complete OPELA or attain at least **80% LDT attendance.** Their subject results are withheld until they have completed a 5-day **Language Development Intensive** program (LDI) in July/February, or the LDO in the following session. On completion of the LDI/LDO, an Authority to Vary Results form is processed by the ALL team and the Subject Coordinator to release their results.
