## **Exhibitors please note**

- This exhibition requires that all exhibitors start with a shirt or shirts - any old shirt, a white shirt, a discarded, coloured or patterned shirt; a large or small shirt; worn, torn, discarded or damaged shirt; plain, frilly or lightweight or heavy; a nightshirt, a child's shirt, a women's, shirt or a men's shirt.
- Shirts are to be transformed into - new piece, an artwork, a functional object or a new wearable article; a unique art or design work.
- All work must be for sale.
- Artists can propose one or two works.
- There will an exhibition fee will be \$1400 - ten exhibitors, so \$140 each. Sturt will issue a tax invoice for 50% to be paid on signing the contract – I'll will pay this and the 2<sup>nd</sup> invoice issued in July before work delivery. I'll ask to be reimbursed in July.
- There may be opportunities to give workshops so you are interested in offering one, can send a brief proposal to LW to forward to Sturt and they will follow up.
- Sturt has asked if we are interested in an exhibition talk after the opening – I think we should so please let me know if you would be interested in giving a presentation.
- Any suggestions for a special quest to open exhibition please let me know.

## **Timeline**

### **• Monday 30 January 2023 – all submitted**

1. A 100-word statement describing the exhibition and the work that will be exhibiting.
2. List of artists confirmed for the exhibition.
3. A current cv for each artist or link to website.
4. A signed exhibition agreement.

### **• Tuesday 28 February for Sturt's deadline of Wednesday 1 March 2023**

Sturt prefers that I gather all information from artists and forward by the 1 March deadline.

Please send to LW by 28 February –

1. A short 50-word statement that describes your work / practice – this is a statement about the work you are planning to exhibit.
2. A supplier form – attached to this email, please complete and return to LW.
3. A studio image of artist high res (3MB) - this is an image of you in your studio or you making your work.

• **Sunday 30 April for Sturt's deadline of Monday 1 May 2023**

Please send to LW by Sunday 30 April -

1. A high res image /s of your work that will be exhibited - good quality (3mb min), labelled with the name of your work and your name.
2. A short 50-word statement about the work you will be exhibiting.

• **Friday 30 June for Sturt's deadline of Saturday July 1 2023**

Please send to LW by Friday 30 June -

1. Completed 'Artist List of Works' attached to this email.
2. Any special hanging instructions must be discussed with gallery prior to install.
3. Price of artwork - Gallery commission is 33.3% and all works must be for sale.

• **Sunday 16 July for delivery to Sturt by Tuesday 18 July 18 2023**

All works can be delivered to Barometer Gallery or LW by Sunday 16 July to be taken to Sturt Gallery by Tuesday 18 July between 9am-12pm.

All work needs to be labelled well with title corresponding to artist list.

• **Sunday 23 July 2023.**

Exhibition opening at 11am and artist talks at 1pm.

• **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> September 9.30 – 1pm.**

Collection of Work - work to be collected from Sturt Gallery by this date, unless another arrangement is made between the artist and Sturt Gallery. Closer to this time we will work out collection.
