

# Wear it with pride.....

Congratulations! You are now 'Games Ready.' Remember, you are the 'image' of the Games, so please wear your uniform in accordance with the following guidelines. Enjoy wearing it with pride.

## Wear and Care

- "Care Instruction" labels will be attached to each uniform item and it will be your responsibility to clean and care for your uniform kit.

## Shoes

- You will be required to provide your own footwear which should be clean, comfortable and conservative in colour (ie white, brown or black) with minimal logos. For safety reasons, open shoes (ie sandals) and high heels will not be permitted. A good example of acceptable footwear would be sandshoes, sports shoes, sneakers, boat shoes etc.

## Additional Clothing and Accessories

- Please be aware that alternative garments and accessories may be worn to ensure religious or cultural requirements are observed, provided you remain easily identifiable as a member of GamesForce 2000.
- If you need to wear additional layers of clothing with your uniform to protect yourself from the cold, please 'layer up' under your poloshirt to ensure you remain easily identifiable as a member of GamesForce 2000.

## Lost, damaged or stolen uniforms

- It is your responsibility to look after your uniform kit. Lost, damaged or stolen items may not be replaced. Genuine requests for replacement of lost, damaged or stolen items should be submitted to your Venue Staffing Team for consideration. Please note that any replacement will be subject to availability of stock.

## Faulty Items

- If you need to replace a faulty uniform item you should return it to the Uniform Distribution & Accreditation Centre. Alternatively, you can take the item to your Venue Staffing Team at your venue who will investigate the possibility of a replacement.

## Pin Wearing

- We ask that you wear no more than five pins on your uniform.

## Swatch Watches

- Swatch the Official Time Keeper of the Olympic Games has kindly donated a number of watches for our volunteer recognition program. If you have been issued with one please ensure you wear it at all times when in uniform.
